Romans 12:9-13

- 1) <sup>9</sup>Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. <sup>10</sup>Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. <sup>11</sup>Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. 2) <sup>12</sup>Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. <sup>13</sup>Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

- 3) <sup>1</sup>Have mercy on me, my God, have mercy on me, for in you I take refuge. I will take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed. 4) <sup>2</sup>I cry out to God Most High, to God, who vindicates me. 5) <sup>3</sup>He sends from heaven and saves me, rebuking those who hotly pursue me – God sends forth his love and his faithfulness.

- 6) <sup>19</sup>“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. 7) <sup>20</sup>But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. 8) <sup>21</sup>For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
